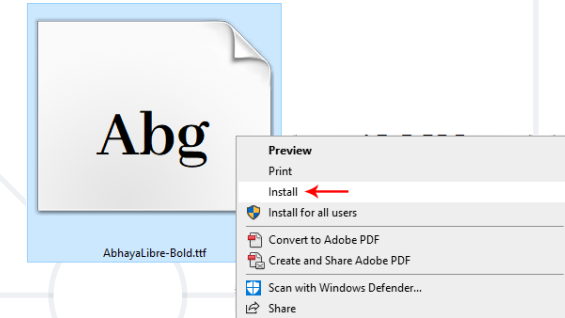


Installing Fonts

In Windows, you unarchive the font files (if you downloaded them in a .RAR), right mouse button click on the file/s and click Install.

All available (installed) font in Windows can be found in C:\Windows\Fonts



The process of installing fonts on different font managers may vary. In the case of FontBase, it involves 2 steps:

1. Place the font files in the manager's font folder - C:\Users\[YOUR PC/USER NAME]\FontBase. You can create different folder for different types of fonts for easier sorting
2. Search for and activate the font in the manager. On the right of the font name there's a small icon, which indicates the status of the font – full green is activated, empty indicates inactive. A circle icon indicates font, which are installed in the manager's folder, squares indicate online fonts (i.e. Google Fonts)

You may need to restart the software you're planning to use with the newly installed fonts. In this case – Photoshop.

Font come in different file formats. The most commonly used are .TTF and .OTF
